


## FINANCIAL IMPACT:

## CHALLENGES

- Additional growth of more than 1,500 students creates a serious need for additional classroom and support space at all grade levels and all buildings.
- Without additional space, classroom enrollment would likely increase, classes offered would be reduced and students would be taught in spaces not intended for learning.
- The rapidly growing district population, coupled with limited space, has created a challenge for several departments providing services to students.

## SOLUTIONS

- Construct a new 528 student elementary school.
- Construct a new 528 student middle school.
- Construct an Educational Support Center to improve technology, maintenance, and food services to students.
